1. Learned counsel for respondent seeks and is granted one week's time to file additional affidavit in terms of para 3 of order dated 28.02.2023 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court with advance copy to other side. Response thereto, if any, be filed within one week thereafter.
2. During hearing, it has been pointed out by learned counsel for respondent that in order dated 09.08.2023, learned Trial Court has observed the non-cooperative conduct of the appellant herein. Though the said petition is not before this Court, however, in the interest of justice, we hereby direct the learned Trial Court to proceed in the divorce petition

pending before it and conclude the same within three months from today.

3. It is made clear that if any of the parties seeks adjournment before the learned Trial Court, the same shall be granted subject to payment of cost of Rs.25,000/-.

4. It is further made clear that if any of the parties does not lead evidence or does not cross-examine the witnesses, the same shall be subject to payment of cost of Rs.50,000/-.
